



2011 Velocity Stage Race
Saturday, May 14 – Sunday, May 15
~ presented by the Velocity Cycling Club ~

Location: Time Trial (Saturday, am) and Road Race (Sunday) – Josephburg Criterium (Saturday, pm) – Alberta Research Park, Edmonton

Entry Fees: \$100 (all Categories 18 and over); U-17 category, \$60.00; Para category, \$60.00. Fee includes post-race meal after Sunday's race.

Registration: Registration will be via Zone4, starting Thursday May 5th at 8:00 am and closing Thursday May 12th at 11:59 pm.

Please note:

- field limits of 50 riders per category will be in effect for all categories
- riders must be registered during the time frames specified; Friday and/or race day registration will not be accepted. This is to facilitate the assigning of race numbers and to prepare the time trial start list, which will be posted on the Velocity site Friday afternoon.
- You will not fill in a road race body number when you register – see below

Race Numbers Race numbers will be generated via the timing system when you register online.
Race numbers and frame plates can be picked up Friday evening (6-8:00 pm) at the **Velocity shop (New Location - 9833 - 63 Avenue, Edmonton, AB)** or prior to the Time Trial on Saturday, beginning at 7:30am.

Please ensure you gauge your time wisely when deciding when and where to get your numbers! Please remember: being on time for your TT start is *your* responsibility; plus, if you pick up your numbers on Friday, you can sleep in a wee bit Saturday ☺

Please Note:

Racers are asked to supply their own safety pins and zip-ties, please!

Sign-on: Velocity Shop, Friday evening or Josephburg Recreation Grounds - Twp Rd 550 west of RR 213.

Directions: Travel East on Hwy 16 Turn left on Hwy 830 travel North, Turn right on Twp 550. Josephburg Recreation Grounds is on right-hand side approximately 2 km after crossing railroad tracks. Again – gauge your time wisely!

Please note:

In order to race, riders must fulfill TWO criteria: be pre-registered (see above) and be in possession of an ABA, or other CCA/UCI affiliate, 2011 license.

No license = no race.

Not pre-registered by Thursday, May 12th at 11:59 pm = no race.

A start list will be posted on www.zone4.ca by 6pm Friday, May 13th.

STAGE EVENT DETAILS:

Time Trial: Saturday May 14th ~ Distance is 10km
Start time 8:30 am. Cyclists leave at 30-second intervals. The Time Trial will be staged from Josephburg Recreational Grounds. **Absolutely no parking at the Moyer Recreation Centre in Josephburg.**
The Course Starts: East of RR 213 on TWP 550
turning: South on RR 112
West on TWP 544
North on RR 213
The Finish will be 80 meters before the junction of TWP 550.
Neutral Wheel Pit at halfway point.

*****Please No Riding other than racing on the TT course in either direction after 8:30 am.*****

Criterion: Saturday, May 14th
Course is located at Alberta Research Park (250 Karl Clark Road – south end of Alberta Research Park at 23rd Avenue and Parson's Road on Edmonton's south side).

*****Sign on Sheets for Crit will be posted on a bus shelter near to the start. Be sure to locate these and SIGN ON at least 15 minutes prior to your crit.*****

One prime for bonus time (3s, 2s, 1s), plus bonus time for top 3 at finish (6s, 4s, 2s), for each category.

Road Race: Sunday, May 15th
As a condition of our permit: **no parking** of vehicles on the course or in the feed zone. There is ample parking at the Josephburg

Recreation Grounds. (See note below)

Sign-on for the Road Race will take place at the Josephburg Recreation Center, between 8:30-9:45.
Road Race **starts** at **10:00 am**, Sunday May 2nd, at the Moyer Recreation Centre. We will have a neutralized rolling start to the northwest corner of the course, approximately 1 km from registration to the corner of TWP 550 and RR 214.

The Course is:

East on TWP 550
South on RR 212
East on TWP 544
South on RR 211
West TWP 542
North RR 214
East TWP 550

The finish will be at the Josephburg Recreation Grounds at the corner of TWP 550 and RR 213.

Race Numbers Placement:

Time Trial – one number: middle of lower back, as low as possible

criterium – two numbers: right rib-cage, facing sideways + right lower back + frame plate

Road Race – two numbers: right rib-cage, facing sideways + right lower back + frame plate

**** Important** – please place numbers according to instructions provided above and at sign-on, and use at least 6 pins per number. If Commissaires and photo-finish cannot identify you due to poor number placement, you may be classified as “did-not-finish”.**

Prizes:

Cash and merchandise, depending upon race entry. A prize list will be posted at the start of the road race.

Reminders:

- No team or unauthorized following vehicles in Time Trial or Road Race stages.
- This event is a timed stage race run in accordance with UCI Regulations - riders must finish each stage in order to continue onto the next! Riders lapped and pulled in the Criterium will be given a calculated time and permitted to start the Road Race.

- **A note about the Centreline/Median Regulation:** Sunday's Road Race features narrow country roads with no marked, yellow centreline. According to the conditions of our permit, and race rules, we are permitted to race only on the right side of the road. If a rider crosses the median of the road and is in the oncoming traffic lane, she/he is contravening both the rules of the race and the law. Such actions will be penalized by disqualification. It is unlikely the commissaires will be able to communicate this disqualification until after the race. Should a significant number of riders in a category disregard the median rule, please expect the race to be stopped and nullified.
- The UCI junior gear restriction of 7.93 metres will apply to all junior (U19) riders, as well as all U21 women wishing to qualify for Western Canada Summer Games. For any questions regarding Provincial Team selection, please contact Cameron McKnight, cam@albertabicycle.ab.ca
- Do not cross the finish line, in either direction, more than once at the end of the race.
- Please respect law enforcement and locals. Do not antagonize.
- Riders should at all times ride single file when not racing.

Post race meal is held back at the Moyer Recreation Centre. Once racers have been fed, families are invited to eat.
